PRIME SPONSORED BILL SUMMARY**

SENATE BILL 1281

This bill allows a child whose parents have been called or ordered to active military duty to enroll in a Pennsylvania Cyber School. It will designate that if a child's parents own a residence in the school district that child will be considered a resident of that particular school district.

Presently, if a military family is stationed in another state and owns a residence in Pennsylvania their child is not eligible to attend a Pennsylvania cyber school.
